Scratch Meeting: Scratch meetings will be held at the start of warmups. Scratches are generally permitted only in the event of illness, accident, or injury. The meet referee must approve other scratches. If a swimmer is entered to replace a scratched swimmer, the new swimmer will take the scratched swimmer's seeding. Events will not be re-seeded in the event of scratches.

What is Due? All coaches' entry grid sheets, computerized entry data, event fees, scholarship forms, and advertisement information are due no later than 8:00 p.m., Friday, July 9. All teams are required to provide the correct information in the proper format or the CCAA Board reserves the right to withhold their admittance into the CCAA Championship Meet.

CCAA Championship Meet Procedures

1. A swimmer may enter only **two** individual strokes, plus the individual medley, and **two** relays. The three-event rule for teams that are short-handed in an age group **does not apply** in the CCAA Championship Meet.
2. A team may enter up to **two** swimmers per individual event.
3. A swimmer is eligible for the CCAA Championship Meet **only** if he or she has competed in **two** scheduled dual meets during the regular season.
4. A team may enter only **one** relay team per event. All names for relay events (both primary swimmers and possible alternates) must be listed **on the back of the coaches' entry sheets**.
5. Exhibition swims will not be available.
6. Entries must be submitted as computerized data, in the format to be specified by the CCAA. In addition, an official entry grid sheet must be submitted for each age group, showing each swimmer's first and last name, age (as of June 1), and seed time listed under the appropriate event number. **Seed times MUST be based on a 25 meter pool**. The seeding committee reserves the right to require verification of any submitted time.
7. Changes in individual events will only be permitted if made during the scratch meeting held prior to each day's events. Substitutions are permitted only in the event of accident, illness, or injury. Changes in the makeup of relays are permitted for any reason, provided that the swimmers being added to the relay are listed among the alternates on the back of the coaches' entry sheets.
8. **Entry costs:**

Individual events	\$1.50 per swimmer per event
Relays	\$5.00 per relay team

9. The order of events will be:

July 18: Events 5-9; 15-19; 25-29; 35-39;
and 45-47.

July 19: Events 10-14; 20-24; 30-34; 40-44;
and 48-52.

July 20: Events 0-4 and 53-62.

10. Awards to be given:

- Regular season: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each league (If ties exist, there may not be 3rd place)
- Team sportsmanship awards
- Championship Meet ribbons: 1st through 10th place in each event (available at the end of the meet)
- Championship Meet team trophies: 1st through 4th place teams
- Championship Meet team awards: highest team totals for girls and for boys
- Team Age Group awards: highest scoring team in each age group
- Individual Medals: **AA** and **A** times
- Louise Stuhr Award: Winner of 8 and under girls' backstroke
- Brittany Dejeet Award: Winner of 11-12 girls' freestyle
- Chene Moore Award: Winner of 11-12 boys' breaststroke
- T-shirt design contest winner
- Scholarships for graduating seniors
- Carolyn Keller Scholarship

11. Each league will be responsible for cleaning up the pool area after one of the three sessions. The **Blue League** is responsible for Sunday cleanup, the **White League** for Monday cleanup, and the **Red League** for Tuesday cleanup.

12. **Seating**: Chairs will not be allowed inside the roped areas around the pool. Tall chairs and chairs with umbrellas are not permitted on the front row of seating or anywhere that can interfere with the

viewing ability of spectators. Front row seats are reserved for coaches, with a maximum of two per team. Assistants beyond the two front row seats must be placed in the second row. DO NOT arrive on Friday or Saturday to place chairs. No chairs may be placed until Sunday morning, AFTER the pool opens at 8:00 a.m. for meet preparations. Any chairs placed prior to that will be removed.

13. **Standing Area** An area will be marked off where observers may stand to watch individual events. This will be for people who do not wish to sit and watch the entire meet, but have come to watch a particular swimmer. There will be no chairs allowed in this area.
14. **Parking:** The JCC will charge a \$3.00 per car parking fee during each night of the CCAA Championship. Please let your team's parents know about this fee in advance.
